Established in 1692, Hartenberg Estate should need little introduction, as one of South Africa's oldest wineries. Hartenberg is nestled on the free draining north-eastern slopes of the Bottelary Hills in the Stellenbosch region, where the Mediterranean climate, cool breezes channelled down the valley from the ocean, and poor gravelly soils are great for grape growing. As a leading member of the Biodiversity and Wine Initiative in South Africa, they have established various initiatives to protect the 170 hectares of natural wetland on the farm, ensuring the health of the vines and a sustainable future for the estate. The wines are consistently pure, elegant and terroir-driven.

Deep black in colour, it reveals classic aromas of cigar box, pencil shavings, and truffle, layered over ripe, richly concentrated red and black fruits. Judicious oak handling and vibrant acidity provide an impressive structural framework, to which the pure fruit clings effortlessly, leading to a long finish marked by fine, lingering tannins.
